









Number of job ad listings relative to before Covid-19. We would expect to see businesses hiring again as economic activity picks up. Number of views of jobs ads should pick up as people get back to more normal activity levels. We would expect to see increased broadband data use on the Chorus network when people are home, for social connection, more entertainment and working from home. We would expect to see increased traffic congestion as people go back to work, school and other usual travel patterns.
